## Spray Rates

TruRange™ offers a new way for ranchers to provide high-quality forage for their cattle in an environmentally sustainable and effective manner. TruRange provides residual weed and brush control in one easy-to-use, low-rate product with no grazing restrictions. With less active ingredient going into the environment and an affordable price, TruRange brings innovation and sustainability to pasture and rangeland management.

### Rates for Different Sized Spray Tanks

- **Weed Rate** – 68 g/ac with recommended minimum 20 gal/ac (76 L) of water
- **Tree Rate** – 136 gal/ac with recommended minimum 50 gal/ac (189 L) of water

### How to Mix TruRange

1. Create TruRange slurry in separate jug – make sure the granules are dissolved
2. Add 50% water to spray tank
3. Add in TruRange slurry
4. Add in last 50% water
5. Add in 0.25% v/v non-ionic surfactant

### How to Clean Tank

1. Drain tank, then flush tank, boom and hoses with clean water for a minimum of 10 minutes. Visually inspect tank to assure removal of all visible residues of TruRange. If necessary, repeat step 1.
2. Fill the tank with clean water then add one liter HOUSEHOLD AMMONIA (containing a minimum 3% ammonia) per 100 liters of water. Fill boom and hoses with solution and allow sprayer to sit for 15 minutes. Drain.
3. Repeat step 2.
4. Nozzles and screens should be removed and cleaned separately. To remove traces of ammonia, rinse the tank, hoses and booms thoroughly with clean water.
